Capacity Crowd honors four at Hall of Fame Ceremony

The 41st annual Hall of Fame induction ceremony was a roaring success with a capacity crowd of 275 on hand to witness the induction the class of 2000. The four inductees were: Anthony “Tony” Strickland class of 1978, William “Bill” Hallal class of 1973, Ted Horansky class of 1975, and

Sam Ruvolo who coached football at Latin from 1960 –1968.

The Hall of Fame banquet was held Nov. 10 at the newly remodeled Hilton Cleveland South Hotel, in Independence. The cocktail reception was followed by a sit down dinner and induction ceremony.

Leo Hyland ‘77, vice-president of the Cathedral Latin Alumni Association, did the honors of providing a brief introduction of each of the award recipients.

Tony Strickland was the first award recipient of the evening. Tony, who still lives and works in the Cleveland area, was described as “a true point guard” during Latin’s resurgence as a hardwood power in the late 1970s. In his junior year, the Lions won the basketball state championship. As captain of the team during his senior year, the Lions were Crown Conference, district and regional champions.

Tony joined teammates Colin Irish, Karl Morris, Ed Washington, Geoff Warren, Michael Harris and Bob Lowrie, who was in attendance, in the Hall of Fame.

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The second inductee of the evening was Ted Horansky '75. Ted participated in both football and track during his years at Latin. A two-year starter on the varsity football team, he earned All-Crown Conference and All-Ohio honors. During his senior year in track, Ted had the honor of competing in the state finals in Columbus as a shot putter. His prowess in football earned Ted a scholarship to the University of Notre Dame, where started as offensive guard on the 1977 national championship team.

Ted joined his brother, Mark '72, as a member of the Cathedral Latin Hall of Fame. Ted and his family live and work in the Cleveland area.

The third inductee of the evening was Bill Hallal '73. Bill was an outstanding running back on the 1971

and 1972 football teams. Bill joined teammates "Dubber" Ward, Jim Weiler, and Gary Jeter in the Hall of Fame. Both Jim and Gary were in attendance to congratulate Bill on his induction. Bill was the third leading scorer on this team, ranked second in rushing, and was the leading kick-off returner. Bill lives and works in the Cleveland area.

Coach Sam Ruvolo coached varsity football at Latin from 1960 – 1968. His eight years as head football coach ranks second only to Herb Eisele in tenure. His record of 49 wins ranks second again to legendary Herb Eisele. His 1960 football team was the East Senate tri-champs and the 1961 team was Senate co-champs. The 1961 team played in the annual Charity football game at the former Cleveland Municipal Stadium.

Many of Ruvolo's former players attended his induction, including Hall of Famers Larry Kaminiski '62, Tom Rodeno '64, Tom Saxe '65 and Frank Titus '66. Sam and his wife live and work in Las Vegas, Nevada.

Leo also recognized members of the Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin 2000 state championship golf team who were in attendance as special guests. The golf team is the school's first state and received a warm applause and congratulations from the crowd.

Latin grad gift to fund auditorium project

A bequest of more than \$190,000 from Cathedral Latin alumnus Frank Bartak '38 is the first significant amount to be included in the school's new auditorium fund.

An honors student all four years at Latin, Bartak worked a variety of jobs throughout his high school years to pay his tuition during the Depression. He was always very proud of his education at Latin.

Upon graduation, he attended Adelbert College of Western Reserve University. Yielding to his love for the sea, Bartak attended basic school at San Mateo, Calif. Spending much of his time at sea, he graduated from the U.S. Merchant Marine Academy in New York in May, 1946. On June 12, 1946 he was awarded a BBA degree from Adelbert College of Western Reserve University.

In 1952, Bartak sailed aboard the SS Enterprise, and was the ship's chief mate. In December 1952, while in

extremely rough water off the French coast, the Enterprise split her seams. All were ordered to abandon ship. As chief mate, Bartak was responsible for an orderly and successful rescue of all aboard.

Bartak retired from active duty at sea in 1953. After receiving his Masters License that same year, he attended Cleveland Marshall

Law School where he earned his law degree with honors in 1954. He worked for Great Lakes Towing Company as a maritime attorney. In 1965, he went to Washington, D.C. and worked for the U.S. Justice Department and Federal Maritime Commission as a maritime attorney. He retired in 1988.

Bartak died in 1999. His brother, Paul, and sister-in-law, Virginia, both passed away in 2000. He is survived by two brothers, Robert and John.

The school plans to honor Bartak with a plaque naming a room for him when the new auditorium is constructed.
