Francis "Frank" Gaul '45



Frank played starting tackle on two Latin Charity Game winning Football Teams in 1943 and 1944.

As a junior, Frank played on the 1943 team that won 7 and lost 2. They won the East Senate Title and the Charity Game against Lincoln High School 18-12, before 40,582 fans at Cleveland Municipal Stadium for the City Title.

As a senior, he was selected 2nd team *Cleveland Press* All-Scholastic on the 1944 team that won 10 and lost 0. Frank blocked for an offense that scored 382 points which is the second most points scored in school history. The offense racked up such winning scores as 104-6, 63-0, 61-0, 45-0,

Joseph "Joe" Iliano '79

Joe is one of the finest all-around athletes ever to graduate from Cathedral Latin School. He represents the last graduating class in the school's existence. Joe earned seven varsity letters, two in football, two in basketball and three in baseball. He was awarded the Nick Schweiker Award in recognition of his athletic contribution to the School.



As a senior linebacker on the 1978 football team Joe set a school record when he returned an interception for 88 yards for a touchdown. He was a major factor in holding a typical St. Ignatius' high-powered offence to just two field goals in the Lions 12-6 victory in the final meeting of the arch-rivals. Joe also had a key fumble recovery to preserve a 7-0 victory

Tony Pozelnik

In this issue I wanted to highlight Anthony (Tony) Pozelnik '31, one of our oldest alumnus, long-time alumni trustee and Cathedral Latin School

supporter, who passed away on June 25, 2011. Tony was born in 1912, graduated from St. Vitus School in 1927, graduated from Cathedral Latin in 1931 and from the University of Dayton in 1935. At Cathedral Latin, Tony played football and basketball, under coach Herb Eisele and was inducted into the Cathedral Latin Sports Hall of Fame in 1983. He continued to play football at The University of Dayton under coach Harry Baujan. After college Tony was a supervisor at the former Superior Boys Town, and worked in the open hearth at Otis Steel Company during World War II. He later worked at Dominion East Ohio Gas Company, where he was president of The Credit Union Board of Directors for nine years, and from which he retired in 1975.

Tony was a member of many organizations including: The Bishop Baraga Assn., Friends of Slovenian National Home, National Cleveland-Style Polka Hall of Fame, St. Vitus Alumni, St. Vitus Holy Name Society, Cathedral Latin Alumni Assn., KSKJ St. Vitus Lodge No. 25 and AMLA Lodge Clairwood No. 40.

Tony was an alumni trustee for many years and was still attending our association meetings and events well into his eighties. He was a splendid example of a Cathedral Latin Alumni: someone who was educated, worked hard, practiced and lived his Catholic faith, and gave back to many organizations with his service and personal efforts and financial means as well.

and 33-0. Latin running backs Cliff Oliver, Leo Hyland, Bill Feldkircher, and Jimmy Eisenman each scored 10 or more touchdowns bolstered by perhaps the best offensive line in school history with bookend tackles Bill McKeon and Frank Gaul. The 1944 Lions football team turned in one of the biggest upsets in Ohio high school history with a 6-0 win over Massillon. The Lions won the East Senate Title and went on to win the Charity Game 33-0 against Lincoln High School before a crowd of 52,888 at the stadium. They were awarded the Ohio High School State Title for their perfect season.

Frank Gaul went on to letter in football at Notre Dame and played on the 1947 National Championship team. He was drafted in the 1949 NFL Draft by the New York Bulldogs in the 20th round (193 overall).

Frank worked for the Cuyahoga County Port Authority and served on Cleveland City Council. He was the Treasurer of Cuyahoga County from 1976 to 1995.

He is married to Ella and has 4 children – Frank Jr. '70, Daniel '72, Kevin '74 and Margaret. He currently resides in Westlake, OH.

Frank Gaul joins 7 other members of the class of 1945 making it the most honored class in the Hall of Fame.
