He was nominated by former Hall of Fame teammates and was the "heart and soul" of the team because of his playing with reckless abandon. Known for his

uncanny ability to sense upcoming plays, the coaches allowed him to play "up or down" from his middle guard/ middle linebacker position. This allowed Mike to lead the team with nearly 110 solo and assisted

tackles which led his team to win the Crown Conference Championship.

With Mike's intense style of play, he helped the Latin defense hold other teams scoreless in five games and to an average of just 5.1 points per game during a ten game season.

While not receiving awards for all-city and/or conference play, his football talents and ability were recognized by numerous colleges and Mike received a football scholarship to the University of Kentucky. Following knee surgery, Mike subsequently walked on and received another scholarship to the University of Wyoming before moving on to serve our Great Nation by enlisting in the U.S. Air Force in 1976.

Initially serving as a Security Policeman (SP), he enrolled at St. Joseph's University in Albuquerque where he concentrated on academics, and graduated Summa Cum Laude with a pre-law and criminology degree. Upon graduation, Mike was selected for Navigator Training, flew global refueling missions in the KC-135, subsequently lead 40 U.S. and foreign officers through

an intensive year-long subsonic and supersonic Pilot Training program, was ultimately promoted to major, and served as Chief of Global Operations for the 22nd Air Refueling Wing.

Receiving an MA in International Relations from the University of Southern California and an MBA from the University of California, Riverside, both while flying as a co-pilot and aircraft commander of the KC-135 and KC-10, Mike has had a distinguished 22-year career on Wall Street in advising wealthy families, private and public companies, churches and non-profit organizations across the U.S.

Mike currently is Senior Vice President – Investment Officer for Wells Fargo Advisors in Naples, Florida. He is married to Paula and they have five daughters: Christy, Leanne, Andrea, Christina and Michelle.

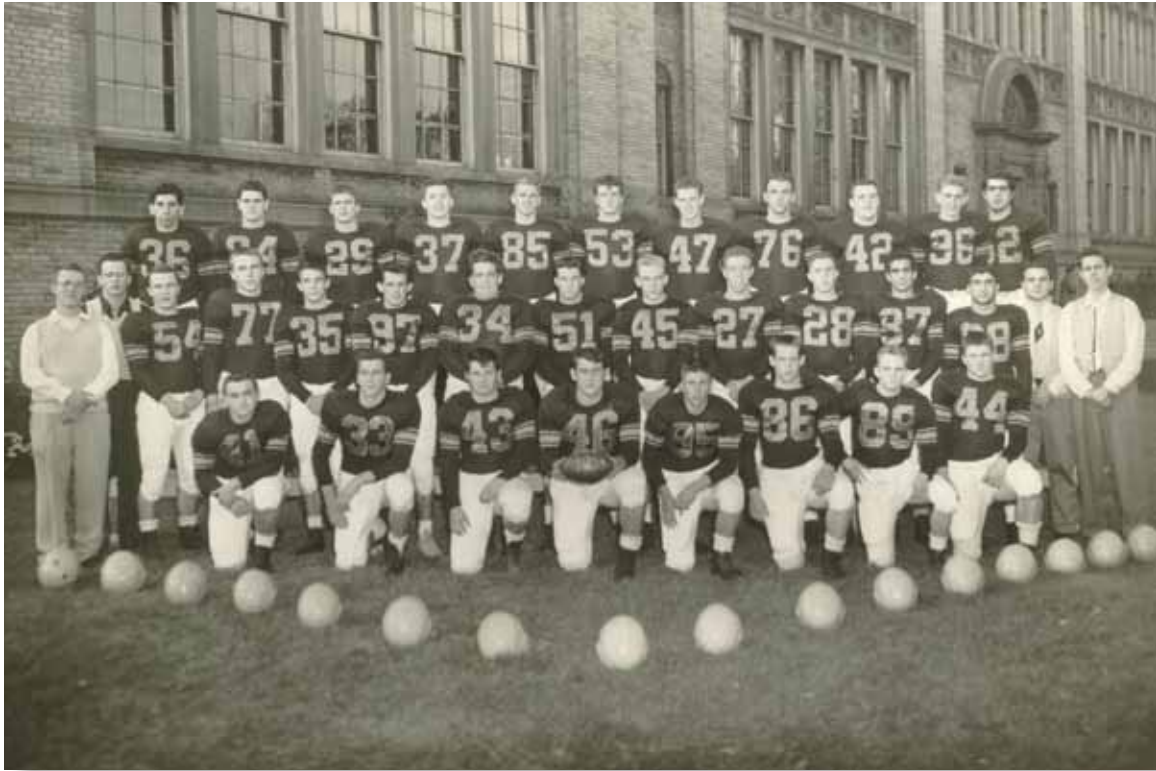

high powered offense tallied scores of 40, 40, 44, 46, 58, 61, and the third highest in school history, 74 points. The Lion defense had shut out six straight opponents leading the school to its 13th City Championship. Led by co-captains Pete Pucher '55 and Bob Fitzgerald '55, this team has eleven of its members inducted into the Hall of Fame. Latin head coach Dan Mormile was named the state's high school "Coach of the Year."

As stated by Dick Zunt (former *Plain Dealer* sportswriter) in his nomination letter, "This team ranks as one of the greats in Cleveland and Ohio high school history."

Longtime (30 years) football official Bob Brown Jr. wrote in his nomination letter, "I have over the years officiated at Canton McKinley, Massillon, Warren-Harding, and Cincinnati Moeller, and the 1954 Latin team was second to none of those teams."
