

## Cathedral Latin Man of the Year: Roger Abood '61



St. Peter Chanel High School President and Principal Roger Abood '61, a well-known Catholic educator in the Cleveland area, has been chosen to receive

the highest honor of the Cathedral Latin Alumni Association, the Merit Award, for 2008. The annual Merit Award is given to one who by his conduct and example has brought renown to Cathedral Latin School.

Abood will be honored at the association's annual Communion Breakfast to be held on Sunday, April 27 at the Notre Dame Education Center on the campus at Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin School in Munson Township.

After Latin, Roger went on to John Carroll University for undergraduate and graduate degrees in the sciences, with further graduate work at John Carroll, Ursuline College, and the University of Dayton.

Abood has been a teacher, coach and administrator at Chanel since 1967 and was appointed principal in 1987. He taught many science courses, including anatomy, biology, chemistry and earth science. He also taught at Cuyahoga Community College.

Abood has been recognized for his professional contributions by Chanel, John Carroll and the North Coast League. He also has been honored as North Coast League Baseball Coach of the Year.

Abood followed his older brother, Jim '47, to Latin, but says it was the reputation of CLS at St. Ann School that was the most compelling reason for making his choice.

He recalls that he was most impressed with the devotion of the Marianists to Mary and that priest and brothers were authentic people – that they smiled and were interested in you. In particular he recalls Brother Frank, Brother Tonry, Brother Conlon, and Brother Geiger. Also important was the dedication of the lay faculty, and the ‘addendum’ of Mr. Ternansky.

Of course, as most alumni remember, he noted the vibration of the gym during the rallies and the spirit of the senior class.

The experience at CLS was responsible for his decision to be an educator. His impression of CLS will never be lost to him.

Roger and his wife, Kathleen, have four children and nine grandchildren.

# The Business of Rebuilding

## Joe Marinucci '72 is in the thick of Cleveland's resurgence



Cathedral Latin School did its best work molding street-tough teens from Cleveland's ethnic, working class neighborhoods into responsible young men ready for college, career and responsible citizenship.

Joe Marinucci '72 could serve as a poster child for that legacy.

The Lions' bone-crunching, all-Crown Conference linebacker surrendered his playing days to a knee injury playing for Ohio Wesleyan University. He pushed on to earn a bachelor's degree in political science at Cleveland State University and found an unplanned career in community and economic development.

His skills in strategic planning, real estate development, financing, public policy development and business retention and expansion have been polished working for Cuyahoga County, the state of Ohio, city of Cleveland, Playhouse Square Foundation, the Downtown Cleveland Partnership and the Downtown Cleveland Alliance.

Since returning to Cleveland as Mayor Michael White's director of economic development in 1990, Joe has been in the thick of high-profile projects that have triggered unprecedented investment in the long-ailing city. Among those that bear his fingerprints:

- Rock and Roll Hall of Fame and Museum
- Great Lakes Science and Technology Center
- Gateway sports complex for the Indians and Cavaliers
- Playhouse Square Theater District
- Warehouse District
- \$1.3 billion in assorted projects between Public Square and the Innerbelt
- \$200 million Euclid Corridor bus rapid transit line to link Public Square, Midtown,

Fairfax, the Cleveland Clinic campus and a booming University Circle.

The president and CEO of the Downtown Cleveland Alliance enjoys the challenge of helping businesses, civic organizations and government attract private investment and make downtown a more vibrant place to live, work, visit and invest. The alliance uses 40 uniformed staff to clean and patrol downtown day and night, and most recently launched a safety ambassador escort program.

His is a job that requires faith, persistence, patience and thick skin.

"I enjoy development. From a professional perspective, this is what I have done in all its variations – sometimes a little more economic development, sometimes more business development, sometimes a combination of the two. It is hard work, but I do see the progress," says Marinucci.

At age 54, Marinucci is too young to remember the city's glory days. He never saw Millionaire's Row or Euclid Avenue when it teemed with holiday shoppers and office workers. But he shares the vision for reversing decades of decay and blight that played a primary role in his high school's demise.

The embers from the city's Hough and Glenville neighborhood riots were still smoldering when Marinucci arrived at Latin from nearby Holy Rosary Parish in 1968. Drove of residents from neighborhood parishes, which had historically fed Latin's enrollment, were flocking to the suburbs. The city population was falling by more than 125,000 from 1960-70. Business investment and support would soon follow the exodus.

Latin had always enjoyed a healthy pipeline of students from the cramped, winding streets of Little Italy. The drastic social changes of the turbulent 1960s were altering the competitive landscape, however.

"A lot of the older guys from the neighborhood went to Latin, but many of the families were migrating up the hill to South Euclid and Lyndhurst. And St. Joe's was making in-roads, too. But for me, it was between Benedictine and Latin," recalled Marinucci, who was born in Italy and immi-

grated to Cleveland with his parents in 1956.

The cool, aloof Murray Hill kid's four years at Latin were the most tumultuous in the school's history. Racial tensions mounted. Traditional school operations gave way to more liberal methods. Marianist staffing dwindled. The crumbling neighborhood fostered increased violence. School finances were squeezed as enrollment plunged.

"It was a different era back then. We went from a strict dress code and discipline when I started to none. Then they started the modular class system. I guess you could say we were the experiment," Marinucci reflected from his Tower City office.

Despite those challenges, the former football team captain and junior class president says his days at Latin enkindled a spirit of teamwork and accomplishment.

"I remember walking into the gym for my first football rally. The intensity was remarkable. The enthusiasm and camaraderie

was striking to me, because in my youth that's not how things operated. To me, it is a great memory of awakening my school spirit," says Marinucci, his hair still thick and wavy though streaked with silver.

"I got to meet a real cross-section of people at Latin. It was kind of a melting pot – the jocks, geeks, potheads or whatever. You learned to be friends with all different types of people, and I enjoyed that."

Working to rebuild Cleveland 30 years after its collapse triggered Latin's closing is an irony not lost on Marinucci,

who lives in Westlake with his wife, Dani, and their four children.

"Whenever I go by John Hay (high school), I feel a profound sadness. It's still tough seeing it, knowing that across the street a great institution didn't survive," he said.

"Latin was a fully integrated, diverse mixture of people and that is exactly what the community needs today. It's exactly the kind of institution you would build if you were to start from scratch – a tough school that helps form responsible young adults."

# Bob Lally '46

*“When the going gets tough, let the tough get going.”*

– **Frank Leahy, Notre Dame University football coach, 1941-53**

The going got tough for dynamic Bob Lally '46 in the last few years as Parkinson's Disease ravaged his body and robbed him of his independence. But the resiliency and durability that once characterized the famous Latin and Notre Dame championship teams he played on enabled him to “tough it out” until the disease finally sidelined him Jan. 12, 2008 at age 79.

Whatever the popular Lally did, it usually was significant. “I always liked to do things in a big way,” he once said.

The Cleveland native attended St. Gregory the Great School in South Euclid before entering Cathedral Latin in 1942. A natural leader with the traits of a great athlete and fellow student, “Prunes” distinguished himself both scholastically and athletically by his positions as senior class president, Sodality prefect and all-Ohio guard on two state championship football teams. The captain of the gridiron and track squads also served on the yearbook business staff and was salutatorian for his graduating class commencement.

Bob went on to play guard for Notre Dame under famed coach Frank Leahy. During his four years there, the Irish were undefeated and won three national titles. Described as a “scrapper” and a “tough boy,” he never let the fact that he only weighed 185 pounds deter him from his starting position. Remarkably, he played in 63 high school and college football games without a single defeat – 24 victories and a tie at Latin and 38 college wins.

He graduated in 1950 with a business degree but stayed at Notre Dame to earn his law degree. After two years in the profession, however, he grew

restless and bored with its slow pace.

“Being involved in the law was frustrating because it took too long to get things done,” he said.

He worked at his father's roofing company, Norton Brothers, and was co-owner and president for 40 years.

In the meantime, he raised a family, or a football team, as he often joked. He and his first wife, Betty (Koch), had 11 children. After Betty's death, Bob met his current wife, Nancy, a widow with four children. In 1966 their families merged, and in 1968 they had one child together, bringing the grand total

to eight boys and eight girls.

Tom Lally '49 and Jim Lally '59 followed their brother to Latin, as did Bob's sons Chuck '68, Kevin '72, Jim '74 and Mike. Bob was inducted into the Latin Hall of Fame in 1961.

As children grew and grandchildren arrived, one thing stayed constant: Bob's red plaid dinner jacket worn every Christmas. It, like the famed football team he once played for, was legendary.

Lally was a past president of the Notre Dame Club (alumni) of Cleveland, and was its Man of the Year in
