#### History of Cathedral Latin School

In 1916 Cleveland Bishop John Farrelly announced the creation of a new Catholic preparatory school for boys to be built at University Circle - Cathedral Latin School. It opened in the fall of 1916 in temporary quarters in Hitchcock Hall of Western Reserve University at 11105 Euclid Avenue. The permanent home was built on 2056 E. 107th Street between Euclid and Carnegie Avenues. The new building's cornerstone was set in 1917 to initiate the Italian Renaissance design by Boston Architect E. T. Graham. The first eleven graduates commenced from

the school in 1919 at the formal dedication of the new building.



Thirteen diocesan priests staffed the school for academic courses and five Marianist Brothers taught science and business courses. The Society of Mary (Marianist order) of priests and brothers was founded in Bordeaux, France. Cleveland Bishop Amadeus Rappe invited Marianists to Cleveland. When Cathedral Latin opened, the brothers withdrew

from the parish schools in the city and staffed the new preparatory school.

The name was derived in part from the Boston Latin School in Massachusetts to whom the school was modeled after. "Cathedral" was chosen because it was part of the Cleveland Diocese's plan to build a cathedral on the present site of Severance Hall. Thus, the amalgamation of these two words became Cathedral Latin. The school would serve a function for the cathedral community. Bishop Farrelly's plans were never completed following his untimely death in 1921.


Cathedral Latin prospered, nonetheless, and grew with enrollments and facilities. Residence halls for students and faculty were added as well as an annex to the building to accommodate more than 11,000 men from 1916 through the schools closing in 1979. Throughout its history, Latin distinguished itself in academics, extracurricular programs, and athletics in the East Senate with Cleveland's public schools and several other Catholic high schools.

By 1970, Latin's enrollment declined to just over 800 students as neighboring Doan's Corners block deteriorated with urban blight and parents grew wary of neighborhood issues. In 1975, a threatened closing of Cathedral Latin prompted a three week rally of resources including its strong alumni to support the program and manage its future. "Latin is here to Stay" announced a banner on the front of the school. A study to determine future strategies would keep the school open. The effort would only last four years as enrollments continued to fall to 300 students by the end of the decade.

#### Johnny Britt

Johnny Britt is a 1975 graduate of Cathedral Latin School. While at Latin, Johnny played trumpet in the school's Marching Band, Symphonic Band and the prestigious Jazz Lab Band under the direction of Brother Todd Ridder and Brother Tim Wilson. Many will remember his singing performance of "You Are the Sunshine of My Life" by Stevie Wonder at the band's spring concert.

Britt is a multi-talented singer, songwriter, producer, trumpeter, arranger and composer in the entertainment industry and has toured the world and recorded with some of the biggest names in the industry. He signed to Motown Records as the founder, creator and lead singer of his group Impromp2. This group fused jazz, hip hop, rap and soul and has performed at the White House for President Bill Clinton as well as the 1997 Olympic Games.



Johnny received his break after studying music at the prestigious Conservatory of Versailles just outside of Paris, France. Upon his return, he was discovered by Otis Williams of The Temptations who hired Johnny as their youngest ever musical director. This lead to Johnny co-producing the music for the Emmy Award winning *The Temptations Mini Series Movie*.

Britt has earned three #1 Billboard Singles as a songwriter. He has worked with the legendary David Bowie, Quincy Jones, Luther Vandross, Josh Groban, Jennifer Lopez and Maxwell. Most recently he's worked with John Legend and Common on the 2015 Oscars, Annie Lennox 2015 PBS Special, Adam Levine on *The Voice* as well as Little Anthony and The Imperials and ABC'S *The View*.

This year Britt has just released his much anticipated *Martin Meets Miles Vol. 1* CD which is up for a Grammy Nomination Consideration. Inspired by Marvin Gaye and Miles Davis, Johnny has produced a dynamic show and album bringing the influence of these two giants together. This album features eight Marvin Gaye Classics along with one original recording, *Marvin Meets Miles* all performed, arranged and produced by Britt.

# Fate of Cathedral Latin may be decided in 3 weeks

Students, parents, teachers and alumni of Cathedral Latin School, 2056 E. 107th St., are today anxiously awaiting an evaluation report which will recommend whether the school should remain open or be closed in June.

The evaluation report is being prepared by the Society of Mary, the Dayton-based religious order which operates the Catholic high

Daniel O'Loughlin, presi-dent of the school's board of trustees, said today a decision should be made by May 1.

"I don't know what the decision will be," he said.

"The Marianists are reevaluating all their schools in view of the economic situation. Latin has been pinpointed as a problem

The problem is money. O'Loughlin said the school, founded in 1916, has an enrollment of about 400. below considerably its peak of 1100 a decade ago.

While that enrollment has stabilized in the last couple of years, he said, it is not enough to keep the School going.

Students pay tuition of \$575 a year, a total of about \$230,000. The deficit is made up by Latin's alumni, who raise some \$100,000 every year.

"The alumni of this school are fantastic," said O'Loughlin. "They are financially the sixth largest supporters of any second-ary school in the country."

He said costs are greatly reduced because 50% of the staff are religious and are not paid the same way as lay teachers.

"We feel we have pre-served the school through what you might call the bad years," he said. "Now we are looking to the future, what with the alumni support and the development of this area to make it more attractive."

O'Loughlin said the key to continuing the school is to enroll additional students. Latin has tried to attract more, he said, by improving 1 ts academic standards "about 1000%".

"In fact, that's part of our problem. We have been turning away kids who do n o t reach our academic standards," O'Loughlin said.

The school has also devoted much attention to its athletic facilities. Nevertheless, O'Loughlin concedes that Latin's location has been of concern to many would be applicants. Five years a g o considerable pressure was put on school officials to relocate.

"We are satisfied with the location," said O'L-oughlin. "I think we are in a unique and prime area. With the Cleveland Clinic and Case Western Reserve nearby, the future for this area can be good."


END OF THE LINE - The once-proud Cathedral Latin School building, on E. 107 St. near University Circle, has finally bowed to the wrecker's ball. The 63-year-old high school, operated by the Society of Mary (Marianists) graduated its last class in June 1979. The state purchased the school site for construction of a rehabilitation center to be operated by the Bureau of Workers' Compensation and the Ohio Industrial Commission to serve workers with job-related injuries and diseases. After the school's closing was announced by the diocese, a group headed by Latin alumni instituted "Cathedral Latin Tuition Grants" to Catholic high schools in the diocese,

for pupils from families with financial need.

#### The End of an Era

In February 1979, the Marianist provinciate announced the closing of Cathedral Latin. Several efforts were undertaken to save the school by the alumni association to reopen the school with a different administration. However, without diocesan support, the effort did not materialize. In June 1979, Cathedral Latin graduated its last class.

The diocese promptly sold the buildings and land along the west side of East 107th street to the state/city/UCI in 1980. On October 16, 1981, Cathedral Latin was demolished. Corresponding actions to legally shut down and seize the Euclid Avenue strip of undesirable establishments owned by Winston Willis made way for a project suited to the desires of the University Circle master plan. In its space stands the former state-owned W.O. Walker Industrial Rehabilitation facility.


Today, the legacy and traditions of Cathedral Latin live on at NDCL:

- The charging lion painting (formally hung in the Latin gym) was recreated and installed in the McGarry Gymnasium.
- The statue of Mary, donated by the Mooney family after WWII (formerly located by the Marianist's Brothers' house) is near the front school entrance.
- Two street signs are on the campus Bro. Frank's Way & Latin Alumni Drive.
- McGarry Gymnasium named for Michael J. McGarry '46.
- Eugene T. Baker Gym named for Eugene T. Baker '37.
- Lozick Field at Lion Stadium named for Edward Lozick '55.

An estimated \$7 million has been donated to NDCL from Latin alumni and our alumni association. Thirty scholarships have been established by Cathedral Latin Alumni and their families to help future young men and women receive a Catholic education.

The school is grounded in the shared values of both strong educational traditions – shared devotion to Mary, faith formation, academic excellence, school as a community and commitment to service.


