

## Fr. Paul M. Marshall, SM '65



Father Paul Marshall graduated from Cathedral Latin School in 1965. In July of 1965, he entered the novitiate at Marcy, New York and professed his first vows in August of 1966. He earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Dayton in 1969 and began working in youth

programs for the City of Dayton. He served as the Director of the Urban Corps Program for youth services for the city and was honored as one of the Top 10 African American Males for his leadership and contribution to the Dayton community.

### Joseph A. Marinucci '72

Joseph Marinucci currently serves as President and CEO of Downtown Cleveland Alliance (DCA), the largest Special Improvement District in the State of Ohio. DCA is dedicated to improving the pedestrian experience for people who work, live and play in Downtown Cleveland and to attracting additional



private investment to the Central Business District.

Prior to joining DCA, he served as President and Executive Vice President of DCA's predecessor organization, Downtown Cleveland Partnership;

# Fr. Paul M. Marshall, SM '65 (cont'd from page 1)

In 1972, Fr. Paul professed his final vows as a Marianist and earned a master of divinity from the University of St. Michael's College in Toronto in 1976. He was ordained a priest in Dayton that year and was assigned to Cathedral Latin School. He taught religion and was the school chaplain up until the school closed in 1979. He then served in a similar role at Dayton's Chaminade Julienne High School.

He was assigned as pastor of St. Aloysius Parish in Cleveland in 1980 and served through 1997. During those years, he served on the board of trustees at the University of Dayton. He helped found the Ministry to Black Catholic Men and was a member of the Provincial Chapter of the Marianist Province of Cincinnati.

Fr. Paul had a great passion for social and racial justice and promoting the gift of the black Catholic community to the entire church. For many years he was a board member of the National Black Clergy Congress and served as president of the National Black Catholic Clergy Caucus. He spent time at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago and in 2000 he returned to the University of Dayton as associate professor in the Department of Religious Studies.

Fr. Marshall served as rector of the University of Dayton from 2005-2010. As rector, he helped establish the

Marianist Educational Associates, a program that develops a community of lay faculty, staff and administrators dedicated to preserving the University's Marianist heritage. In 2010 he was appointed Assistant for Temporalities for the Marianist Province of the United States, headquartered in St. Louis, Missouri. He served as one of five top leaders where he oversaw Province finances and social justice initiatives.

Sadly, Fr. Paul passed away on July 17, 2014 at the young age of 66. At the time of his death, he was visiting Marianist ministries of the District of India, a dependent unit of the Province of the United States.

In reflection on his 25th Jubilee as a Marianist, he wrote the following:

"The Marianists have always been open to someone of a different culture. Our life together, I believe, is a witness to the kingdom of God. Every race, culture and people are called to be followers of God. Mary, our model of faith, praised God who raised the lowly and freed the oppressed. Working for freedom and promoting the faith in the Black community have given meaning to my life as a Marianist."

Fr. Paul was preceded in death by siblings Carl and Patricia. He is survived by his sister Iris Marshall Brown and brothers Isaiah and Aaron.

Let us thank God for the gift of his life. May he rest in peace.

Vice President of Real Estate Development for Cleveland's Playhouse Square, the country's second largest theater district; Director of Economic Development for the City of Cleveland; and Deputy Director for the Ohio Department of Development.

He has served as Chairman of the Board of International Economic Development Council (IEDC) and was recognized for his 37 years in the ED profession by being awarded Fellow Member, Honorary Life Member, and, in 2016, the Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence in Honor of Edward DeLuca, recognizing his contribution to the economic development profession. He also served as treasurer of IEDC's predecessor organization, the International Council for Urban Economic Development.

In addition, Joe's volunteer contributions included serving on and chairing the Board of The Gateway Economic Corporation, the owner of the Gateway Sports Complex and more recently served on the Cleveland Host Committee for the 2016 Republican National Convention held in Cleveland.

In addition, Mr. Marinucci's current community involvement includes the Union Club Board of Trustees, the Cleveland Restoration Society Board of Trustees, Little Italy Redevelopment Corporation (ex-officio), the Visiting Committee of Levin College of Urban Affairs at CSU, the Advisory Board for the Center of Population Dynamics at CSU, and the Urban Research Park CDE, based in Towson, Maryland.

A graduate of Cleveland State University, Joe was born in Giuliano Teatino, a small town 15 kilometers from the Adriatic Sea in the Chieti Province of Abruzzo, Italy. He migrated to the United States with his parents in 1956 and settled in the Little Italy neighborhood of Cleveland.

Today, he resides with his wife Dani in Westlake, Ohio, where they raised their four children: Antonia, Dante, Lucia and Vincenzo.

My heartiest congratulations to the Class of '51 on the celebration of the Twenty-Fifth anniversary of your graduation from Cathedral Latin High School.

It is my pleasure to add to the occasion by forwarding the enclosed checks which are donations from two former members of the Class of '51, whom I met recently under rather unusual circumstances.

While driving into San Francisco earlier this month, I noticed two middle-aged derelicts standing by the roadside. Picking up hitchhikers is dangerous, but once in a while I like to test my ability to recognize an old altar boy when I see one. This time I felt I saw two. Only after stopping the car and motioning for them to get in, did I notice the signs they were holding -- "Cleveland" and "E 107 St." These two apparent bums were trying to get to Cathedral Latin, my Alma Mater.

After twenty-five years of forever trying to hold before them the vision of the purple and gold, Helfrick and Williams were down on their luck. Every penny that could be saved had been scraped together to send a respectable donation to the Alumni Fund of Cathedral latin. There was nothing left over for postage, transportation, or beer. Such loysly to the Alma Mater could not go unaided, so I assured them that I would see to it that their donation was forwarded in time for the reunion. Their story was brief, but touching. However, as fellow Latin graduates, and gentlemen, they refrained from putting the touch on me.

San Francisco was as far as I could take them. They stumbled out of the car after thanking me profusely for my assistance. Also enclosed is a photo I snapped as they resumed their lonely vigil by the highway, heading east.

Should they not make it to the reunion, this letter will make good my pledge to see that their donation does arrive.

# Fred Zwilling Finally Granted Latin Diploma after 55 years


At their 55th reunion, the Class of 1962 recognized and paid tribute to a deceased classmate who never received a Cathedral Latin diploma. In 1962, four weeks before graduation, Fred Zwilling was denied a diploma and a chance to graduate with his class after beer was discovered in the toilet tank of his room during the Senior Class Retreat. Eventually, Fred went on to graduate from Cleveland Heights High School and enlist in the US Army.

While stationed in Germany, Fred married a German girl (Karen Hertwig) and together they had an infant son, Fred, Jr. Unfortunately, on March 26, 1968, Fred was killed in an automobile accident in Stuttgart, Germany. He left behind a wife and an 18-month-old son. What Fred did was in service to our country and he carried out the words of our Latin fight song, "For God and country right."

While at Latin, Fred was a good and popular student who along with his classmates completed the course of studies prescribed for graduation by Cathedral Latin School. Although Fred's picture appears in the 1962 Latin yearbook, he was not allowed to participate in graduation ceremonies and never received a diploma because of his sophomoric prank at the Senior Retreat.

Fifty-five years later, his classmates Tom Begley, Bob Sheahen and Jim McMahon decided they would petition that a posthumous Latin diploma be awarded to Fred. Since Latin no longer existed, they decided to appeal to the next best existing institution having direct links to Cathedral Latin School. With the help of Sue Wise, their case was presented to Sr. Jacquelyn

Gusdane, then president of Notre Dame-Cathedral Latin School, and Joe Nista '64, Latin Alumni President. They decided that Fred was entitled to a diploma since he had completed the requirements for graduation and that his dismissal may have been an administrative overreaction and not entirely justified. So a posthumous Cathedral Latin diploma was made and officially signed by each of them.



On September 16, 2017 at the 55 year reunion of the Class of 1962, Bob Sheahen, a close grade school and high school friend of Fred, presented the diploma to Fred's brother Don '63. In Bob's words, "So tonight....55 years later...., we get to do something right. We get to restore Fred Zwilling to a place of dignity in our class. Fred Zwilling is a hero of our class and he is a credit to Cathedral Latin School. We have a posthumous diploma for him. Tonight, we are giving Fred's



posthumous diploma to Fred's brother Don. Here, Don, is the diploma and thank you for all your family has done for our school and for all that Fred did "for God and country right." Don later sent the diploma to Fred Zwilling, Jr, who resides in Keller, Texas with his wife Darcie. They have three grown daughters and two grandchildren.

The Class of 1962 hopes that Fred can rest in peace now that he has officially graduated from Cathedral Latin School.


A passionate advocate for the environment, Tom previously served as a board member of the Cape Fear Economic Development Council and the New Hanover

#### 1957



### NDCL Invites Latin Alumni to Reunion 2018


