Scott Klonowski '79 Coaches Priests vs. Seminarians Basketball Game

A large crowd filled LeBron James Arena at St. Vincent-St. Mary High School in Akron on January 19 for the third annual Cleveland Seminarians vs Cleveland Priests basketball game. Klonowski was the head coach for the priests. He was assisted by David Martin and Danny Dusek. John DeAngelo coached the seminarians. His classmate, Chip Tighe '79, helped referee the game.



Spectators, including relatives of the players, traveled from across the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland for the friendly rivalry. They cheered, chanted and waved signs throughout the game.

The priests were victorious, topping the seminarians with a score of 44 to 36. Repeating as the MVP for the priests was Father Kevin Klonowski (Scott's son), who played all 40 minutes and scored 22 points. He also had 7 rebounds and 6 steals.

"It was lots of fun and we'll do it again next year," Father Klonowski said. "It was a tough game and we had to stay on our toes."

Father Klonowski, who helped organize the event, led the closing prayer and offered a blessing.

The game was a fundraiser for the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Diocese of Cleveland. A suggested \$2 donation at the door netted more than \$1,100 for SVDP and a 50/50 raffle generated another \$350.

Ed Strnad '47 Living Life "In Deed & Truth"



Ed was born November 16, 1929 and is the youngest boy of 11 children and the last one remaining. He will be 90 years old this year. He was married to Coletta for 63 years and has missed her daily since she passed away about seven years ago. They married November 19 — three days after his 20th

birthday because his mom said he couldn't marry until he was that age. She said that he didn't wait very long! Before his wife died, she told Ed to do what he has to do and then he can join her. Since that time he's been doing all kinds of things, like taking up the clarinet again, but he hasn't found the one that will lead him to her yet.

Ed plays his clarinet (which he played at Latin) in the Cuyahoga Valley Concert Band and The Czech Band. A few months ago while at his Cuyahoga Valley Concert Band gig, he saw a gentleman with a Latin shirt on. Ed came up behind him and started singing the school song and the man started singing along. Turns out they were in school at the same time!

Ed is still involved in a variety of roles today:

- He is the police chaplain for the Maple Heights Police Department.
- He has been a member of The Singers' Club of Cleveland since 1987 as a loyal bass and as chair of the Sunshine Fund to provide cards and gifts to members during difficult times. As the unofficial chaplain, he stays in touch with anyone not able to

sing for any reason as well as family members in distress. For many years, he housed a wardrobe of spare parts for the white tie and tails the members wear in concert.

- He sings at the Northfield Village Nursing home once a month to "cheer up the older people."
- Every Thursday for over 30+ years, he takes the Eucharist to University Hospital in Bedford and is chaplain on call when a priest isn't available. He stops in the emergency room on these trips plus checks with the intensive care staff to see if he's needed. They all welcome him, but most don't even know his name.
- He volunteers at Cleveland Hopkins as a gold coat to assist passengers.
- He is a perpetual student pilot and has made model planes for most if not all the planes he has piloted.

If you'd ask Ed to turn out his pockets, you'll see he has a small bottle of holy water, a small pencil, his wallet with his chaplain shield and his wedding picture on one side and a picture of them as a couple taken years later. He manages to find someone to show his bride's picture to everywhere he goes and tells them she had baby skin.

Ed was born with dimples. When he sees a child with dimples, he asks, "Do you know where you got those dimples from?" They usually reply, mom, dad, grandma, etc. He says to the girls, "That's where the angel kissed you" and to the boys, as he grabs his own dimples with his thumb and finger, "That's where the angel grabbed you and said, now you be good!"

Brother Roman Wicinski, S.M. '47



Brother Roman attended Cathedral Latin for two years (1944-45) before entering the Marianist preparatory school in Beacon New York. Afterwards he went to Mount St. John in Dayton, Ohio

where he professed his first vows in 1947. Brother Roman graduated from the University of Dayton (B.S. 1950) and the Ohio State University (M.S. 1956). Before leaving for Africa he taught at Chaminade High School, Mineola, New York and at the University of Dayton.

In 1959, Brother Roman was appointed headmaster of St. Patrick College in Asaba, Nigeria. In 1965 he was asked to establish a training center for Nigerian Marianists. He founded and became the first Superior of the Marianists Preparatory School Seminary in Ekpomo, in Edo State Nigeria. The first novices were received in 1967 and two of them pronounced their vows on April 14, 1968.

On April 16, 1968, on his way to Benin City for a headmaster's workshop, he somehow got caught up in a Nigerian Civil War crossfire between Biafran troops and federal Nigerian soldiers at Ogwashi-Uku, a few miles outside of Asaba and was killed. Accurate details of his death are fragmentary. That afternoon, his body was found behind the post office by federal soldiers. He had been handcuffed and shot at least two times, apparently at close range. His corpse was taken first to St. Patrick's College and then to Ekpoma where he is buried next to the chapel. He was only 38 years old.

Brother Roman was one the best liked men of the province for his outstanding community spirit and his engaging sense of humor.

The Marianist Preparatory in Nigeria was eventually closed. It was renamed **The Brother Roman Center** in 1972. The Marianist Brothers returned to America around 1978. Since then the Center has served as a catechetical and renewal center for the Diocese of Uromi, Edo State, Nigeria.

He has also volunteered at the Cuyahoga County Board of Mental Retardation at the Maple Heights Adult Training Center.

His dedication to his religion is unquestioned. He provided volunteer service to St. Rita's Parish through the Family Promise program and was involved in various projects at Saints Cosmas & Damian including teaching PSR classes to junior high school students. Tom tirelessly volunteered his services to the food and clothing distribution program of the St. Vincent De Paul Society at the St. Philomena location in East Cleveland, Ohio. He did everything from unloading pallets of foodstuffs delivered by the Greater Cleveland Food Bank, to actually handing out shopping bags of food to needy families.

In 1981, a few years after Latin closed, Tom Ashdown had the difficult task of carefully removing the WWII plaque from the main hallway before the school was demolished. Thanks to Tom's efforts, the plaque was put in storage, refurbished and is now proudly displayed at NDCL.

For over four decades, Ashdown has held several roles with the alumni association including Vice President and Trustee. In 2001, Tom was awarded the coveted "Golden Alumni Award." This honor had been given to Cathedral Latin graduates who rendered outstanding and distinguished service to the alumni association.

We all know the motto of Cathedral Latin School "Opere Et Veritate," which can be interpreted to mean — doing what is morally right through everyday actions. That certainly seems to describe how Tom has conducted his life in service to others. This goes to show why his fellow classmates describe him as the consummate "Good Guy."

Ashdown's two brothers graduated from Latin – Joe '65 (deceased) and Bill '67. His father, also named Tom, graduated in 1926.

Tom resides in Solon, Ohio with his wife, Maureen. They have five daughters who all attended Catholic schools.

orchestra. Dr. Bastulli was the class Salutatorian and received the Cathedral Latin Alumni Outstanding Graduate Award for Class of 1972. Dr. Bastulli participated in the planning for the Notre Dame Cathedral Latin Dedication Mass.

Dr. Bastulli resides in Cleveland and is the President and Managing Partner of Cleveland Anesthesia Group.

Dr. Bastulli earned his Bachelor of Science degree from Case Western Reserve University and Medical Degree from Northeast Ohio Medical University. He completed his residency training in Anesthesia at University Hospitals of Cleveland followed by a fellowship in Critical Care Medicine at the Cleveland Clinic.

Board certified in both anesthesia and critical care medicine, Dr. Bastulli is Director of the Division of Anesthesia and Medical Director of Surgical Services at the St. Vincent Charity Medical Center. In addition, he is currently the Secretary/Treasurer of the Medical Staff and a member of the Medical Executive Committee, Hospital Board of Directors and Board Finance Committee.

During his two decades at St. Vincent's, Dr. Bastulli has held various leadership roles including a tenure as President of the Medical Staff from 2007 to 2013. He is the only physician in the history of the Medical Staff to be elected to three consecutive terms.

In 2015, St. Vincent's recognized him with its most distinguished honor by inducting him into the Society of St. Luke. The Society of St. Luke was established to recognize and honor selected members of the St.

Vincent Charity Medical Staff for their distinguished service to their patients, the mission and community. Only 31 physicians have been inducted into the Society of St. Luke.

Since 1991, Dr. Bastulli has been a Board Member of the Academy of Medicine of Cleveland and Northern Ohio. He is a past president and currently serves as Vice President of Legislative Affairs and is a member of the Executive Committee, Education Foundation and President of the Academy's Political Action Committee.

Incident to his impact on the medical community of Northeast Ohio, Dr. Bastulli has been the recipient of numerous awards by the Academy of Medicine of Cleveland and Northern Ohio, including the establishment of an award in his name. Dr. Bastulli has received the Academy's Outstanding Service Award and was awarded the Charles L. Hudson, M.D., Distinguished Service Award on two separate occasions. The Hudson award is the highest award the Academy bestows on physicians. In 2012, Dr. Bastulli received the Inaugural Academy of Medicine Education Foundation John A. Bastulli, M.D., Philanthropy Award. The award was named after Dr. Bastulli for his support of the foundation and fundraising efforts.

Dr. Bastulli holds several leadership positions within the Ohio State Medical Association and is currently a member of the Northeast Ohio Medical University Foundation Board and the Cleveland Chapter of the American Heart Association Board of Directors.

Dr. Bastulli currently resides in Shaker Heights, Ohio with his wife, Lorene. They have four children, Cara, John, Jr., David and Mary Katherine. In addition, they have been blessed with two grandchildren, Maeve and Hayden.
