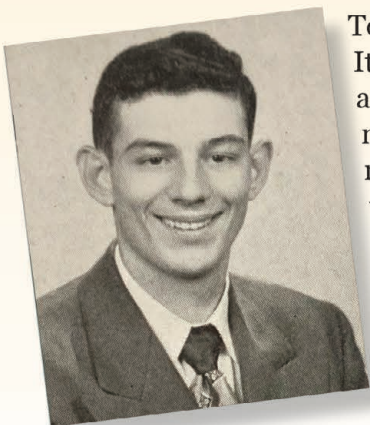

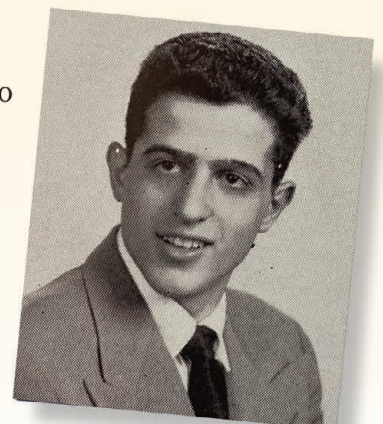

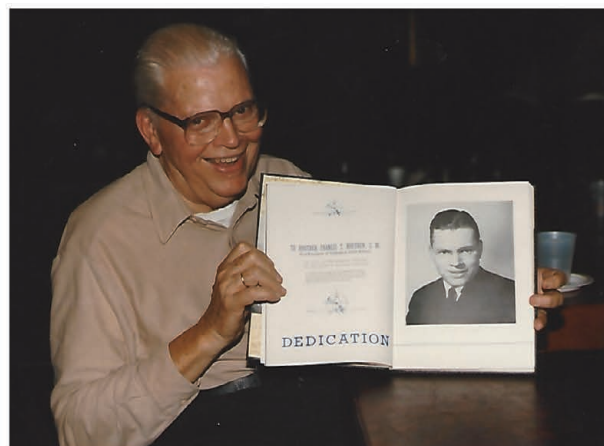

Bro. Jose Cintron, SM



After teaching Latin and Spanish at Cathedral Latin as a Marianist brother in the 1940s, Bro. Jose Cintron, SM was called in a new direction. During childhood, he received art training from his uncle, Miguel Poe, and his love for drawing and painting remained steadfast. Although he cherished his time as a brother, Cintron spent a year in spiritual discernment. He



subsequently felt led to leave the religious life and enroll full-time at the Cleveland Institute of Art. He majored in portrait painting and graduated in 1954. Cintron then organized the first art department at Benedictine High School and also taught art at Collinwood High and East High in Cleveland. He began teaching portrait painting and figure drawing at the Cleveland Institute of Art in 1956 and continued to teach there for the next 50 years. He married in 1961 and had three children, while also teaching classes at the Cooper School of Art from 1963-1983. Over the years, Cintron has painted many portraits of distinguished medical and academic faculty of University Hospitals and Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. Additionally, his portrait "Head Up High" hangs in the Santa Barbara guesthouse of Oprah Winfrey. Today, Cintron is 101 years "young", as he loves to say, and resides in a senior living community in Northeast Ohio.

Cathedral Latin School Cornerstone

In 1981, Cathedral Latin School was demolished. Ken Mueller, Class of 1974, along with classmate Mike McGinty went to the school site and saw the cornerstone to the 1929 annex building on top of many bricks. They knew it had to be saved, so they loaded the 500 lb. stone onto their truck. Ken has stored this piece of history at his home since 1981.

In 2021, Ken offered to donate it to NDCL where it is now proudly displayed at Lion Stadium. The sign reads, Omnis Sapientia A Domino Deo which means All Knowledge Comes from Lord God.

her children's Catholic school tuition. This value on Catholic education was carried on by Tony and his wife, Molly. They made sure all of their seven children and 17 grandchildren attended or will attend Catholic elementary schools, high schools and colleges.

Tony started at St. Philomena School and then attended Cathedral Latin School. Some of his best memories are from his time at Cathedral Latin where he made long lasting friends, many of whom he is still in contact with today. He played freshman, JV and varsity basketball and was vice president of his senior class. Tony loved his teachers at Cathedral Latin, but one of his favorites was Ken Fierle. Mr. Fierle was a terrific teacher and it often took only half of the class time to cover his lesson plan. The rest was spent in wonderful conversations between Tony and his classmates. Other teachers special to Tony included Frank Kirchendorfer, Brother Robert Maguire and Leo Waltchuck. Mr. Waltchuck was his basketball coach. Tony remained a lifelong friend with his classmate Bishop Anthony Pilla who was a freshman with Tony before leaving for the seminary. Despite leaving Latin, Bishop Pilla always considered the Latin class of 1951 to be his high school class and its members his classmates.

After graduating from Latin, Tony attended the University of Notre Dame where he played freshman basketball. He then attended John Carroll University where he played varsity basketball and was awarded a basketball scholarship. Tony went on to Case Western Reserve Law School. While in law school, he juggled several jobs including teaching physical education and coaching basketball at Our Lady of Lourdes High School. He also worked for a shopping service called Wilmark Services and was paid the going rate of \$1 an hour.

In 1959 Tony graduated from Case Western Law School. He started practicing law and steadily built a successful personal injury and worker's compensation law firm with his brother-in-law Ben Miralia. Their firm, Musca & Miralia, still exists today. Tony practiced law for 40 years until retiring in 1999. While practicing law, he purchased his first commercial real estate in 1960, a Convenient Food Mart on E. 222nd. This building is still operating as a convenience store and is owned by the company owned by his seven children – Musca Properties, LLC. While not owning any portion of Musca Properties, LLC, Tony remains involved on a daily basis as a valued consultant to the company.

One of Tony's proudest moments as a Latin alum that many do not know about was donating money for a chapel at NDCL. While happy to donate, NDCL wanted to name the chapel after him and Tony was not comfortable with that. Instead, Tony insisted the chapel be named after Fr. Jim O'Donnell, Latin Class of 1948. Fr. O'Donnell was Tony's childhood neighbor, lifelong friend and someone Tony greatly respects.

Tony is also proud that years ago he and his family started an annual trip to a poor town in El Salvador named Chiltiupán and an even poorer village nearby called Cuervo Arriba. They annually fund about 15 college scholarships for children in these areas who would otherwise have no chance of attending college. Many have now graduated, are successful young people and are honoring the Musca family's request to now help others in need in their communities. Tony's family also funds projects in these areas to provide access to basic necessities like clean water and basic sanitation.

Tony's greatest gifts has been his wife, Mary (the love of his life), their seven children, 17 grandchildren and one great-grandchild. Tony is a prayer warrior. If you know Tony even remotely, there is a good chance that he has prayed for you. His biggest blessings are a loving God and his understanding of the need to give back to those in need.

was captain of the varsity basketball team for several games and chosen All Catholic on the Universe Bulletin team.

Al continued his schooling at John Carroll University where he studied medicine. He was senior class president at John Carroll as well. He subsequently went to medical school at Case Western Reserve University and received his surgical training at Cleveland Metro General Hospital.

After his surgical training, Al became a Lieutenant Commander in the United States Navy. Initially, he was assigned to the Gulf of Tonkin in Vietnam and served as the surgeon in charge of the operating room for the attack aircraft carrier USS Ranger-CVA61. His responsibility was the surgical care of the flight squadrons, the ship's crew, and the wounded personnel flown to his ship from Vietnam.

In his second year in the Navy, Al became part of the surgical team at the United States Naval Hospital at Bethesda, Washington, D.C. His duties there included the surgical care of military personnel, political figures and their relatives, and the training of surgical residents. After he completed his duties at Bethesda, he obtained his pathology training at the Veterans Administration Hospital in West Los Angeles, California. Following his training with the VA, he became deputy coroner for the Los Angeles Coroner's Office. The chief coroner was the famous Tom Noguchi (the coroner of the stars).

After his time in California, Al decided to return to Cleveland and became the plant medical director for the United States Steel Corporation — Cuyahoga Works. He later became part of the surgical department of St. John-West Shore Hospital, ultimately advancing to become chief of surgery and chairman of the Surgical Department. Al was selected to the Society of St. Luke which recognizes and honors selected members of the medical profession for distinguished service to their patients, the community and the mission of the hospital. After working with all these various companies and hospitals, Al started his own medical practice on the West Side of Cleveland and in the process treated many Latin alumni.

The Lord's path for Al and his work in medicine allowed him to interact with many political figures, including U.S. presidents and members of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives as well as U.S. Supreme Court justices, generals and admirals and Catholic Cardinals and Bishops. Despite interacting with such prominent figures, Al says he realizes that most of the very best men he met in his life are those he met while attending Cathedral Latin. Those men include Bishop Anthony Pilla '51, Father Mark Hollis '63, John Hollis '51 (Mark's brother), Father Jim O'Donnell '48, Father Mark DiNardo, Ph.D. '50, Dominic LoGalbo '50, Salvatore Felice '53, Richard Huberty '53 and other classmates.

Al currently resides in Highland Heights, Ohio with his wife, Barbara. He has four children and four grandchildren.

John Viktoryn '65 Endowed Scholarship Fund



What started as a thought from Myles Roche and Dan Flaherty in December of 2022 has turned into a reality in February 2023. The Class of 1965, along with some family members and friends, has established the *John Viktoryn Endowed Scholarship*. The required threshold of \$25,000 has been met.

John served in the 101st Airborne Division as PFC – E3 – Army – Selective Service. His tour began on April 3, 1968. John's body was recovered on May 8, 1968 in Binh Thuan, South Vietnam from hostile ground casualty gun fire. He died at the young age of 21. If you ever visit the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall in Washington, DC you can view his name on Panel 57E – Line 11.

John's father, John Viktoryn, Sr., also attended Cathedral Latin School and graduated in 1923. He excelled in basketball and football. After graduation, he became a doctor and later served as the physician for the football team. In 1963, he was inducted into our

Athletic Hall of Fame. John's brother Elliott also attended Latin and graduated in 1966.

We want to thank all of you for supporting this most noble cause. This scholarship will be a long-lasting legacy to John and will help future NDCL graduates make this world a better place — **“in carrying out the lessons that you taught to serve in deed and truth.”**

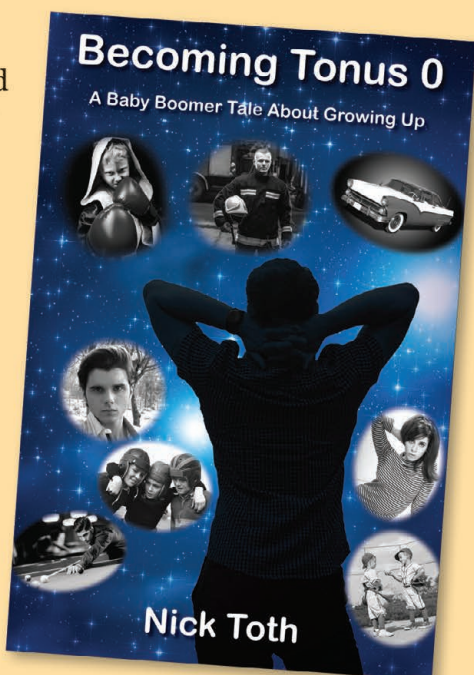


1965
