We all share the good fortune of having attended Latin. There has never been, nor will there ever be, another school like it. The Latin spirit made the school famous and turned boys into men.


This non-profit organization (currently at 3,700 alums) is funded through membership dues, donations, memorial gifts and funds generated by its programs. Last year 978 alumni and friends graciously contributed \$64,067 to support the association. These funds are used to promote secondary Catholic education as well as maintain our database and website, publish and mail the *Alumnotes*, supplement annual events and routinely contribute to the Brother Francis T. Nurthen Endowed Scholarship Fund.

Our alumni association also supports NDCL in various ways by contributing and sponsoring their Annual Fund, Mane Event and Golf Outing. We established an endowed scholarship fund at NDCL in the name of Brother Frank. This fund provides scholarships to deserving NDCL students with a direct legacy to Cathedral Latin School. The current value of the fund is approximately \$330,000 and continues to accept donations.
